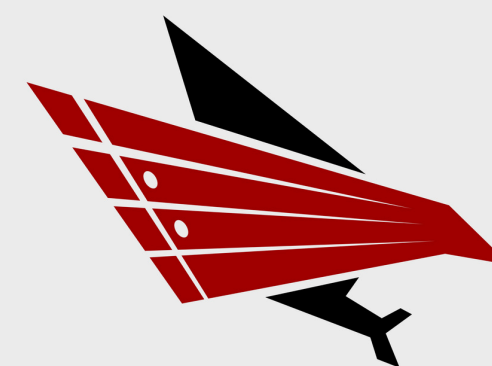

Typical Competition Night

- Rehearsal @ CSHS
- Load, eat (student provided), and get dressed
- Travel
- Perform
- Awards
- Return to CSHS (evening/late)
- Unload

Attendance

- All members are expected to attend every rehearsal and every performance.
- Avoid scheduling appointments, work schedules, etc., during our time together.
- We're all on the same team, working on a giant group project. There is no bench; everyone is expected to achieve, and the judges are watching and evaluating all of you. If one person is absent, the whole team has to react and adjust not only in their absence but days following while that person catches up. Everyone is counting on you to be there and do your job.
- All rehearsals and performances are graded as part of the band curriculum. Like in other classes, if you are absent and miss the classwork or test, you are not excused from the work entirely; you are expected to make up the work. Rehearsals and performances are no different.

Attendance cont'd

How to you handle important conflicts like athletics, FFA, and other important activities?

- **Performances/Games > Rehearsal/Practice**
- Arrangements may be made to split rehearsal-practice and performance-game conflicts.
- Every effort will be made to accommodate schedules in the best interest of the student.
- Any conflicts should be addressed at the beginning of the season to allow for coaches and directors time to collaborate.

Uniform Expectations

- Students are fitted and issued a uniform every August.
- Students are responsible for keeping the uniform in good condition throughout the season.
- Please let Mrs. White know if your uniform needs attention. General wear and tear is normal and can be taken care of if given immediate attention.
- Each complete uniform is roughly **\$480.**
- The marching band uniforms were brand new for the 2021-2022 season. They need to last us at least another 6 seasons. **Please take care of our uniforms!**

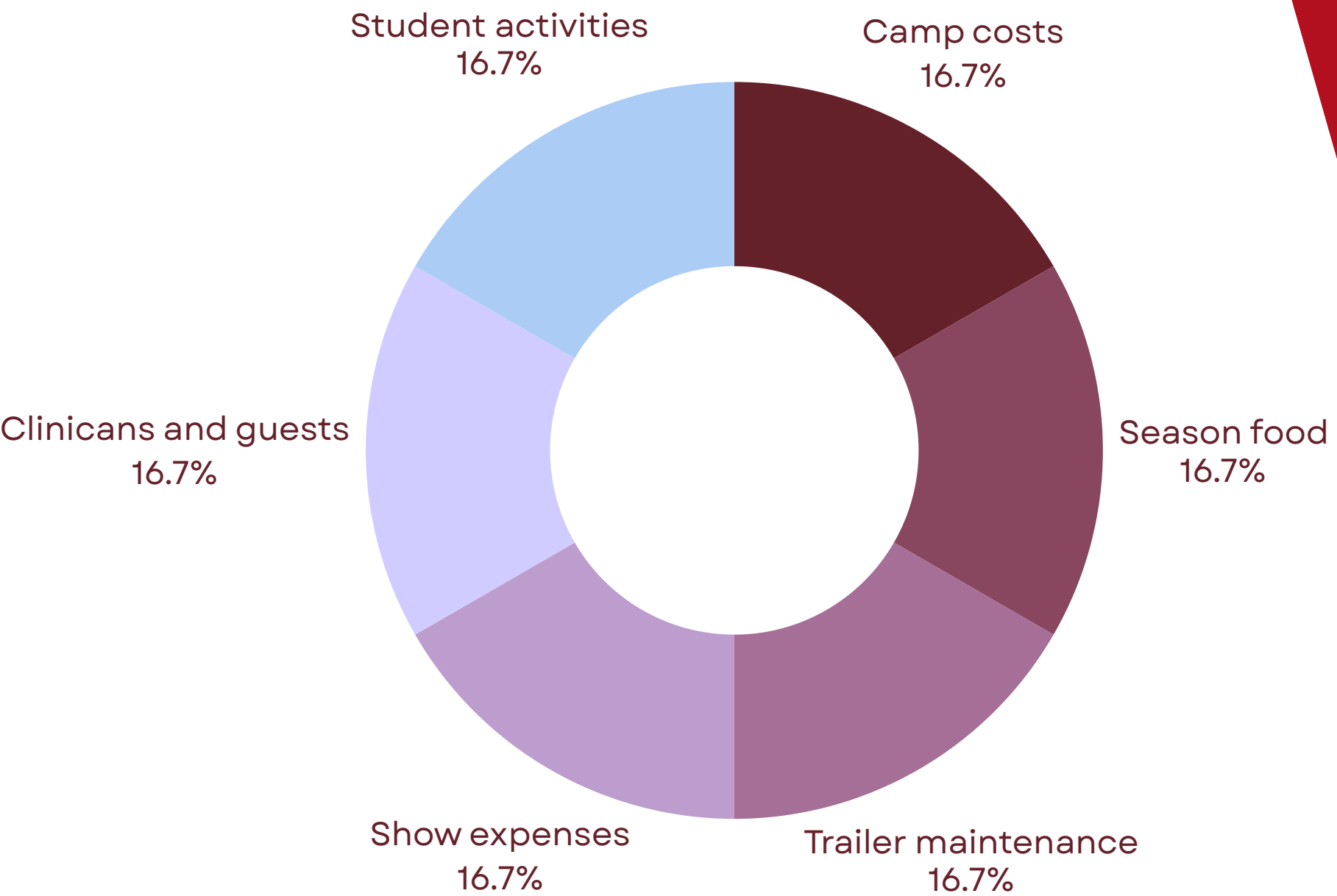
Running the band is a team effort between the district and the boosters. We're expensive to maintain.

Can I do band and take a rigorous course load?

Yes!

FACT: Participation in band improve students' academic success

“Students with coursework/experience in music performance scored 52 points higher on the verbal portion of the SAT and 37 points higher on the math portion than students with no coursework or experience in the arts. The difference in scores increased with the number of years involved. Those who studied music for four or more years scored a combined 101 points higher on the SAT than those with no coursework or experience in the arts.” – College Board Profile

Can I do band and athletics?
