When individuals are absent from any rehearsals, the whole band suffers. Also, during band camp, we pay thousands of dollars to bring in experienced professionals to help teach the drill and music. Please avoid scheduling any appointments or family trips for your child during band camp week.

 - There will be a 5 minute and a 2 minute whistle before 8AM

Weekly Tuesday Rehearsals begin August 19th - ALL MEMBERS, 6PM-9PM

- ❖ Please come prepared to be outside for ALL of the practices on the turf, parking lot, or stadium. In the event of rain, we will still have rehearsal. Practices will continue every Tuesday throughout the season except for a few Wednesdays (please see tentative schedule).
- ❖ It is expected that all members of the marching band attend EVERY rehearsal as it is essential to our success throughout the season. The best bands do not have attendance and participation issues.
- ❖ Colorguard and Percussion have different schedules until after band camp – all practices are listed on the website cedarspringsbands.com under the Cedar Springs Band Calendar tab.

♪PREPARATION FOR CAMP♪

We are preparing to have a fun, productive, and exceptional marching season this year! The foundation for a great season is set at summer rehearsals, pre-camp, and band camp, and we will continue striving for musical excellence by working hard and remaining intensely focused.

REMEMBER:

1. The marching drill is easier to learn if you know your music.
2. Repetitive practice is the best way to memorize. Try to memorize articulation and dynamics at the same time you are working on notes and rhythm. It will be easier than relearning these areas later.
3. BREATHE DEEPLY!!!! - Air is key to great tone, “In Tone = In Tune!”

♪BAND FEES♪

The total amount due for band class this year is \$200. A \$100 deposit (made payable to “Cedar Springs Music Boosters”) will be due on Thursday, May 1st, 2025. The remaining balance of \$100 will be due by Saturday, May 31st, 2025. Please make checks or money orders payable to the *Cedar Springs Music Boosters, PO Box 811, Cedar Springs, MI 49319*. Please complete the “Marching Band Participation Cost Form” found on page 10 of this packet and include this form with your payment. This fee covers the costs of designing the camp meal, transportation of equipment, trailer maintenance and annual fees, and feeding the band students for the school year (more on pg. 9). This is beyond the financial support provided by the school district, which is very supportive of the instrumental music program.

♪WHAT TO BRING♪

- Instrument in good playing condition - EXTRA REEDS, VALVE OIL, SLIDE GREASE, ETC.
- Pencil(s) - Mechanical is best so there is no need to sharpen.
- Flip folder and instrument lyre (clip for the flip folder) with music in clear plastic windows (winds and percussion only). Flip folders are student’s responsibility and are not provided by the school.



- Three-ring binder (1/2" – 1" thick) and some clear plastic sheet protectors
- HAT, SUNGLASSES, AND LIGHT RAINCOAT OR PONCHO
- Cool clothing for field work (shorts, T-shirts, etc. must be loose enough to permit freedom of movement required for marching)
- Warm clothing, depending on the weather (sweatshirts, sweatpants, jackets, etc.)
- GOOD ATHLETIC SHOES (NO SANDALS) AND ATHLETIC SOCKS FOR DRILL WORK. THIS IS A MUST TO HELP AVOID FOOT AND ANKLE INJURIES. BE PREPARED FOR RAINY BAND CAMP DAYS!!!! Students will be on their feet all day and shoes should be comfortable and supportive.
- MOST IMPORTANTLY - Please bring an insulated bottle or hydration pack with at least 20 ounces of water, and clearly write your name on the outside of the container. Water will be available for you to refill your bottle throughout the day at Pre-Camp and Band Camp.
- BUG SPRAY
- SUN BLOCK (SPF 30 OR HIGHER)
- A POSITIVE ATTITUDE AND GRIT

♪WHAT NOT TO BRING♪

- NO SANDALS, CROCS, or other leisure shoes.
- No pop, juice, or energy drinks, etc. WATER ONLY.
- Choose to make wise decisions. If you have a question about whether or not to bring something, *don't* bring it.

♪CONCERNING CAMP RULES♪

- Make up your mind to heed the rules. Remember, an outstanding group is made up of individuals who have enough maturity to relate their behavior to the well-being of the whole organization. Poor choices hinder our progress.
- The Cedar Springs Public Schools Code of Conduct can be found at the district website, as well as, the high school website. This Code of Conduct is developed to establish the best possible learning environment for students and provide for the safety and well-being of all students and employees of Cedar Springs Public Schools. All those enjoying the rights of citizenship in the school community must accept the responsibilities of citizenship and respect the rights of other members of the school community. It is provided to each student as a source of general information, a guide to school policy and an expectation of student responsibility. All students and their parents are expected to read this Code of Conduct and inform themselves accordingly. **THIS CODE APPLIES TO STUDENTS WHETHER IN SCHOOL, OUTSIDE OF SCHOOL, BAND CAMPS, TRAVEL, AND EVEN DURING THE SUMMER AND ON WEEKENDS WHEN PARTICIPATING IN A SCHOOL EVENT. DO NOT BREAK THIS CODE.**
- Cedar Springs Public Schools has a clearly defined, district-wide anti-hazing policy. Hazing of any kind will not be tolerated, should be reported immediately and directly to Mr. Nabozny or Mr. Weber, and will be referred to school administration for disciplinary action. The district defines hazing as follows: Hazing is the act of coercing another to perform any act of initiation into any club, class, group, or organization that is degrading, and causes or creates a risk of causing mental, emotional, or physical harm, even if they are willing. No student, including the victim, shall engage in hazing activities at any time in school facilities, on school property, or off-site. Hazing by any individual, school group, club, or team is not permitted. Students and their parents are asked to report any potential hazing.



♪CAMP RULES♪

PARENTS AND STUDENTS - PLEASE READ THIS SECTION CAREFULLY!

The rules listed below should be thoroughly understood by both students and parents. All parents should read this list carefully and go over it with your children. These rules will be the same for all band activities throughout the school year.

The Cedar Springs Public Schools student code of conduct will be in effect. The school and district rules are expected to be followed at all times.

- Avoid behavior that is potentially injurious to any individual including yourself, or detrimental to the welfare of the band. At ALL times both in and out of rehearsal, on or off campus, marching band members will conduct themselves as dignified young people, making responsible choices that reflect positively on our program.
- BE EARLY TO ALL ACTIVITIES. This will contribute to our success at camp and throughout the year.
- All students are responsible for the cleaning and maintenance of the school facilities..
- Use good sense and manners at meals.
- Students are expected to eat the meals that are provided for them unless a food allergy prohibits them. This includes breakfast, lunch, dinner, and snacks. It is important that students fuel themselves, as marching and playing instruments are physically demanding.
- Please dress in a manner that is respectful of others. Clothing that includes profane or inappropriate content (i.e. sexual innuendo, references to drugs or alcohol, or discriminatory content) is strictly prohibited. Please refer to the "Student Dress Code" found in the student handbook.
- WATCH YOUR LANGUAGE!!! Understand tact, you represent the band program.
- Do not embarrass yourself and others with public displays of affection, this is clearly stated in the student code of conduct.
- Respect the property of other band members and the school at all times. IF YOU BREAK/DAMAGE SOMETHING, YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE TO PAY FOR THE REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT.
- NO VISITORS AT CAMP. ONLY REGISTERED PARENT VOLUNTEERS/STAFF ARE ALLOWED AT CAMP. Students will not be allowed to leave camp for any length of time.
- The Cedar Springs Marching Band strictly enforces a No Bullying policy. Bullying includes gossip, back talk, arguing, physical confrontation, hazing, taunting, and mocking. Use of social media such as Twitter, Facebook, etc. must be in line with standards of conduct in person and on campus.
- Terrible actions and choices bring discredit to the student, parents, band program, and Cedar Springs High School, and there will be consequences. The following will NOT be tolerated in the Cedar Springs Band Program:
 - THE USE OF TOBACCO, ALCOHOL, E-CIGARETTES, VAPES, AND CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES BY STUDENTS; USE OF ANY OF THESE BY A MINOR IS ILLEGAL
 - DISOBEDIENCE OR RUDENESS (BACK TALK) TO ANY STAFF MEMBER
 - MAKING THREATS TOWARD/INTIMIDATION OF OTHER BAND MEMBERS OR STAFF
 - UNEXCUSED ABSENCES FROM ANY BAND ACTIVITY
- Members will treat each other, staff members, and parent volunteers with courtesy and respect.



♪REHEARSALS♪

- Attendance is **MANDATORY** for every rehearsal (unless otherwise specifically stated) for the entirety of the rehearsal.
- All members will be on time for each rehearsal. "On time" means on the field ready to go with all necessary equipment at the designated start time. Students should arrive at the school at least 10 minutes before the start of rehearsal to allow time to get set up and get on the field.
- Students must notify the directors at least 24 hours in advance of any time conflicts with other activities such as sports. If a student participates in a fall sport and has a time conflict with practice/games and rehearsal they are expected to come to a time agreement with both the directors and their coach.
- While students are not allowed to miss marching band rehearsals or performances because of heavy homework/study loads, marching band rehearsals or travel schedules are never an excuse for a student to neglect their academic responsibilities.
- The use of cell phones during rehearsal is prohibited unless directed by a staff member (for use as a metronome or tuner etc.). Phones are not allowed on the field or in rehearsal space.
- Members will not bring personal issues or negative discussions into the rehearsal environment.
- Rehearsals are a time to learn everyone else's part, please be well prepared on your own part.

♪DRESS♪

- Attire for rehearsals, including Pre-Camp and Band Camp, needs to be flexible and functional. Comfortable, light colored, athletic clothing is recommended. Quite often, mornings are cool and afternoons are HOT! As the season enters into fall students should be prepared to march in cold temperatures and possibly rain. Students need to come prepared to march in **ALL** of these conditions. The student dress code applies at all times.
- All hair must be pinned up completely inside the shako (hat)
- Piercings should be as small as possible. Don't make it big, don't make it obvious.

♪ PRE-CAMP AND BAND CAMP SPECIFIC INFORMATION ♪

- School policy will not allow us to distribute any type of medication. If a student develops a headache, runny nose, or twists an ankle, we can not administer any aspirin, Tylenol, Benadryl, or the like, they will have to come prepared.
- Due to legal liability, **NO BAND MEMBER WILL LEAVE CAMPUS DURING BAND CAMP SCHEDULED TIMES**. A student will only be permitted to leave campus if accompanied by a parent. A note will not be sufficient. There will be no exceptions to this rule.
- Signups for Fall concessions and other Fall volunteer jobs will be available tonight or during Tuesday night rehearsals, uniform fitting, and band camp week. Please see the attached information sheet for more details.
- Again, the cost for the band class this year will be \$200. \$100 is due by Thursday, May 1st and the remaining \$100 payment is due by Saturday, May 31st. See the Band Participation Cost form for available discounts.
- A uniform care/replacement, band commitment, and health form have been included. It is imperative that we have permission to treat your child if we cannot reach you. The signed health/band commitment form is due back to the band room by Saturday, May 31st.



- ALL BAND PARTICIPATION COSTS MUST BE PAID BY Saturday, May 31st. Uniforms will only be issued to those students who have paid all fees.
- FINANCIAL NEED – If you know you will have problems paying the fees on time, please speak with a director to make accommodations. No student will be denied the opportunity to participate for financial reasons. There will be many opportunities to fundraise throughout the year.

Band Participation fees for Cedar Springs High School covers many things that our participants often don't realize are a part of our program. Here is a brief summary of the items that our organization has to fund as a part of our program:

- ❖ Student section shirts for band camp
- ❖ Awards, letters, and pins for student achievements
- ❖ Supplies for student activities including banquets, parties, locker decorations, etc
- ❖ Uniform maintenance
- ❖ Uniform purchases, new items required, and items that are not reusable from season to season
- ❖ Show props and accents
- ❖ Trailer maintenance, fuel to travel to competitions, and insurance
- ❖ Organization fees and taxes, including a third-party accountant
- ❖ Assist in additional training for drum majors and section leaders

As a non-profit booster organization, it is a part of our tax law that these items are spelled out and reported on a monthly basis. These reports are available for review at the monthly boosters meeting, which are typically held the third Thursday of every month. Notifications of the meeting schedules are posted via the group's current communication methods.

COMMITMENT FORM

Uniform and Equipment - Student:

I will keep my uniform in good condition, as instructed how to care for the uniform. If any repairs need to be made, I will advise a music booster. I understand that my uniform, hat and shoes will be kept in the band room storage area after each performance. If any portion of my uniform is not returned at the end of the year or is returned in an unrepairable condition, I understand that I will be required to pay a replacement fee. During the marching season, I also understand that it is my responsibility to attend all performances (competitions, football games, parades, etc.) dressed in proper attire which includes a black t-shirt or long sleeve, or optional 2025 marching band show shirt, black socks, black marching shoes and white gloves or assigned color guard costume. During the concert season, I understand that it is my responsibility to attend all performances dressed in proper attire which includes black socks or black nylons with assigned black shoes and my concert uniform. I realize that I am responsible for any equipment I am issued for use and that I may be charged for its loss or damage.

Commitment - Student:

By signing this form, I am making the commitment to participate in the Cedar Springs High School Band program during the 2025-2026 school year. It is my responsibility to attend all scheduled camps, rehearsals, parades, football games, community performances and competitions. I understand that it is my responsibility to notify the director and Colorguard/Drumline/Front Ensemble instructor as soon as possible if I am unable to be at a performance or rehearsal by phone call, email or parental-signed note. Performances: Directors and instructors must be notified no later than 2 weeks prior to the scheduled performance for a planned absence. Rehearsals: Directors and instructors must be notified no later than 24 hours in advance for a planned absence. I understand that the directors will understand if emergencies arise that do not allow for prior notice. A written note after the emergency has subsided will suffice. I understand that it is my responsibility to stress the importance of punctuality to my parents so that I do not suffer negative consequences for tardiness or absenteeism. I understand that Pre-Camp and Band Camp are mandatory.

Parents:

I give my child permission to participate in the Cedar Springs High School Band program during the 2025-2026 school year, and realize that attendance for the entire time, at all practices and performances, is required to perform and compete successfully. I understand the above statements and the commitment that my child is making to the CSHS Band program. I understand the terms of payment in full, whether paid by Paypal, check or money order. I understand that my child needs to be at all of these practices and performances on time and will notify the director as soon as possible when my child will be tardy or absent from practices. I understand that music booster meetings are held throughout the year and that because my child is in band, I am a music booster. I understand that my attendance at these meetings are not mandatory, but highly encouraged.
